


Outgoing Mail Server Authentication Setup for Outlook Express 5/6

Step 1:

Open Microsoft Outlook Express. At the top click on '**Tools**' then '**Accounts**'.




Step 2:

In the Internet Accounts window, click the '**Mail**' tab.

Step 3:

Select **pop.citenet.net** and click on the **Properties** button.



Step 4:

In the Properties window, click the **Servers** tab.

Step 5:

Under '**Incoming Mail Server**', type in your **full email address** (e.g. jsmith@citenet.net) and password in the respective fields.

Under '**Outgoing Mail Server**', check off '**My server requires authentication**'.

Click on '**Settings**'.



Step 6:

Ensure that '**Use same settings as my incoming mail server**' is selected.


This option ensures that the email address and password you entered in the previous window will be used to authenticate you when you send an email.

Click '**OK**'.



Step 7:

Select the **"Advanced"** tab and change the **Outgoing server (SMTP)** port to **587** and Click **OK** at the bottom of the **"Internet E-mail Settings"** window.



Step 8:

Click **'Finish'**
