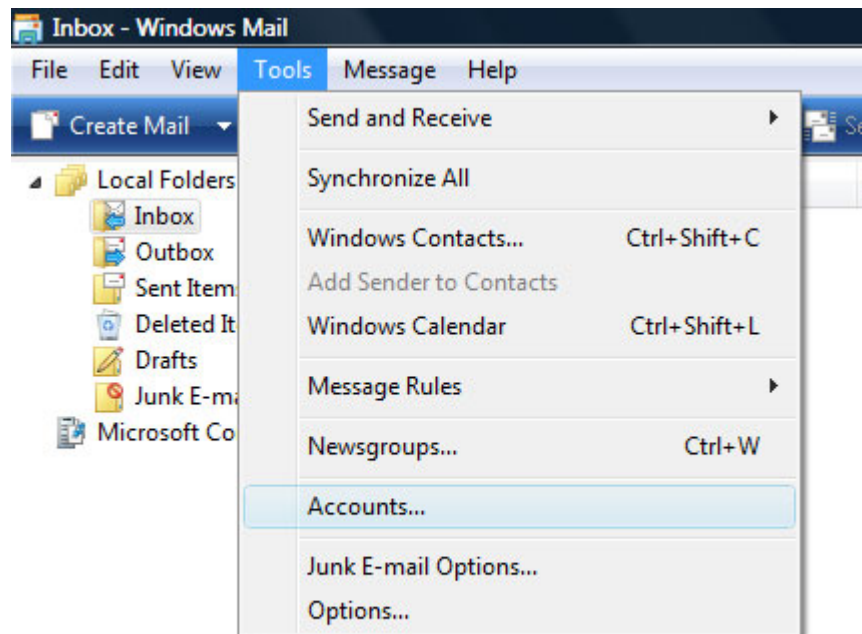


Outgoing Mail Server Authentication Setup for Windows Mail

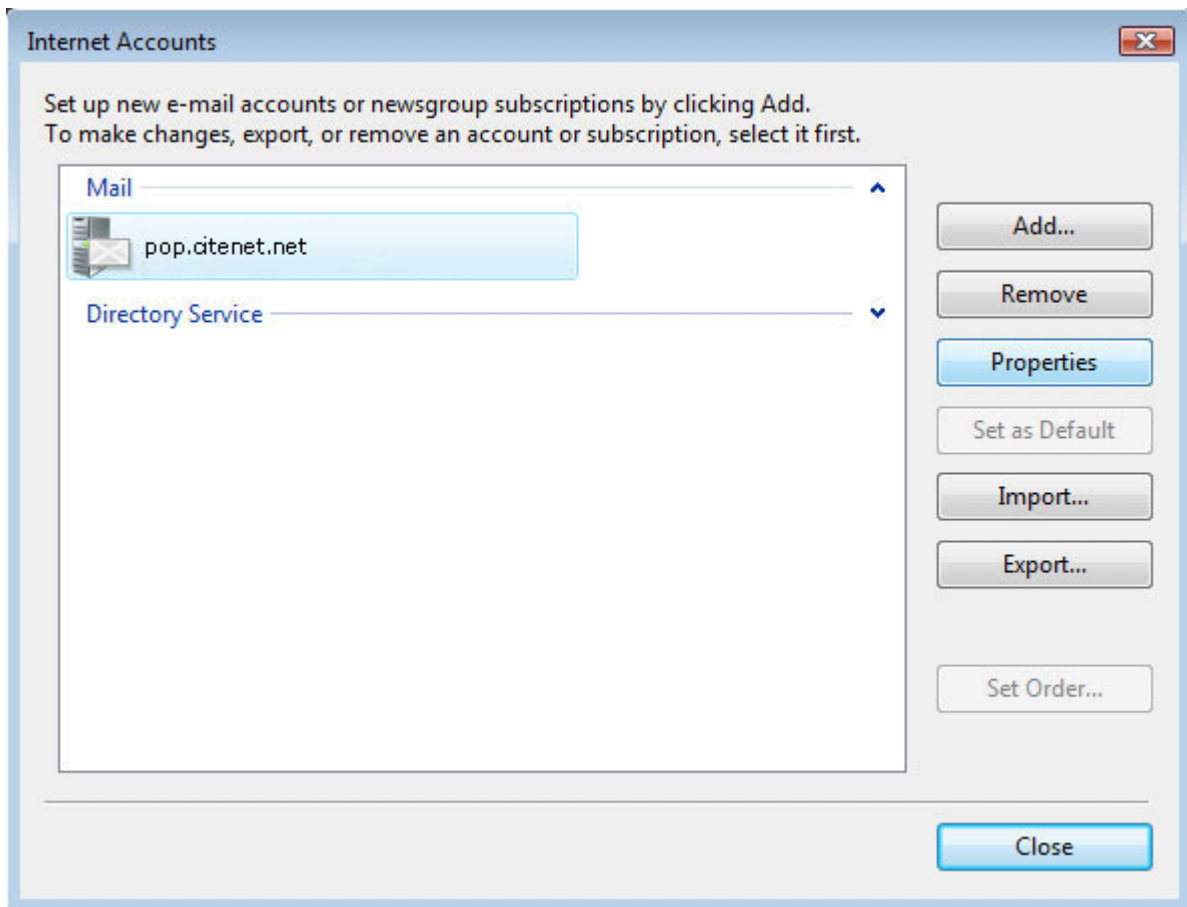
Step 1:

Open Windows Mail. Click on **'Tools'** and select **'Accounts'**




Step 2:

Select the email account you wish to configure for Outgoing Mail Server Authentication. Click **'Properties'**.



Step 3:

Click on the 'Servers' tab. Check off "My server requires authentication". Select the "Advanced" tab.



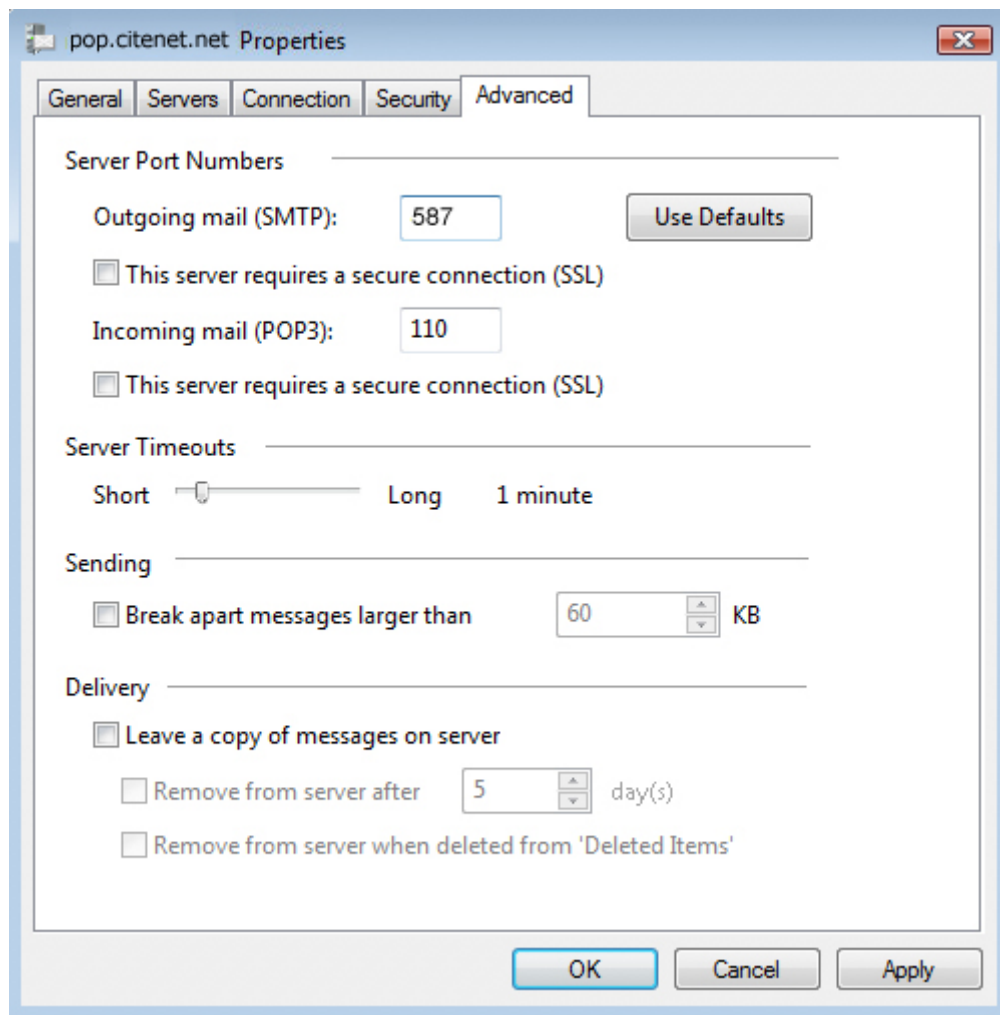
